On March 23, 1775, at the Second Virginia Convention at St. John's Church in Richmond, Paul Revere spoke that famous line: "Give me liberty or give me death." This would lead to the American Revolution. We have the same opportunity today, liberty or death. We are certain death. Another Paul wrote, "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23) And "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 6:23) But Jesus Christ brings liberty and life. Jesus came proclaiming liberty. He said of himself, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed." (Luke 45:18) Through Christ we have liberty from the bondage of sin. Paul wrote, "Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage." (Galatians 5:1) And through Christ we have life. Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die." (John 11:25-26) After this revelation what will you choose, liberty or death?




