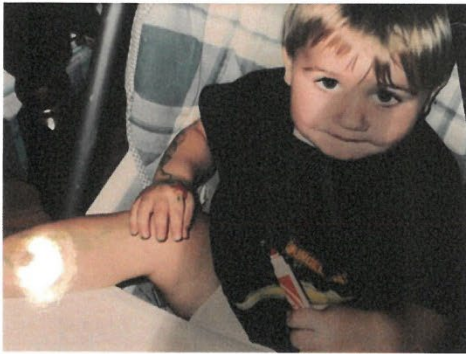

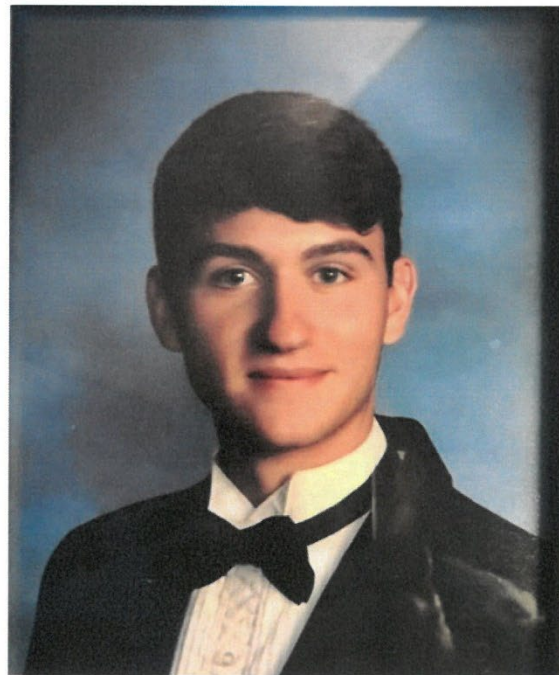
Carson Brown
