Sometimes as Christians we can become overly critical. Critical of our country, critical of our community, critical of our church and even critical of other Christians. Many Christians have a reputation of just being grouchy. Do you think that is how Jesus wants us to be? Rev. Adrian Rogers asks, "Are you grumbly hateful, or humbly grateful?" Yes, it is easy to become negative and grumble. But as Christians we are to be grateful. Paul gives us three steps to being "humbly grateful" in 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18. He writes, "*Rejoice always*,

pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."



First, Paul says to rejoice always. Happiness come from whatever "happens" to us, but joy comes from Jesus. Second, Paul continues, "pray without ceasing." In Philippians 4:6 Paul tells us not to be anxious about things but to pray. Finally,


